30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD – May 14 through June 12, 2018

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on the proposed Offsite Interim Remedial Measures Work Plan Addendum (Addendum) for Cherry Aerospace located at 1224 East Warner Avenue, Santa Ana, California 92705 (Site).

Why is cleanup necessary? Investigations under DTSC's oversight have revealed the presence of chemicals including volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and 1, 4-dioxane, in groundwater at and beyond the Site boundary and in soil at select locations on the Site.

In 2015, DTSC approved an Interim Remedial Measures Work Plan (IRMWP) to contain the chemicals within the Site's boundary by extracting groundwater and soil gas while investigations continued, and long-term corrective action alternatives were evaluated. Subsequent investigations indicated that chemicals had spread in the groundwater beyond the Site boundary toward the south-southwest where groundwater impacted with similar chemicals from other facilities north of the Site have also spread. As a result of the subsequent investigations, the 2015 IRMWP has been modified to include additional actions that will address the off-site VOC-impacted groundwater and to some extent groundwater impacted with chemicals from other facilities which are present in the area south-southwest of the Site. Based on currently available information, the chemicals in the soil and groundwater do not pose any immediate health concern and local drinking water meets all applicable State and Federal standards. In compliance with California Environmental Quality Act, an addendum to 2015 Negative Declaration has been prepared for this project. A public meeting has not been scheduled for this project.
