On November 17, 2016, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the Part A and B applications for renewal of the RCRA Hazardous Waste Facility Permit and Post-Closure Permit from Chevron Products Company (Chevron), El Segundo Refinery (the Facility). The facility is located at 324 West El Segundo Blvd., El Segundo, California (see Figure 1 at the end of this Public Notice for a map). Chevron requests authorization from DTSC to continue the storage and treatment of hazardous waste and Post-Closure care of the Landfarm. After DTSC completes its review of the permit applications, DTSC will then prepare a draft permit for public review and comment.

Chevron generates a variety of RCRA hazardous wastes from the processing of crude oil. Crude oil is a complex naturally occurring mixture of predominantly hydrocarbons and/or sulfur, nitrogen, and oxygen derivatives of hydrocarbons. Its composition varies with source. Chevron is authorized to store and treat these on-site generated wastes in containers and tanks at a designated area in the facility. Chevron also has a landfarm unit that was used to store, treat, and dispose of hazardous waste. However, this unit ceased operations in 1987 and is no longer operating. Closure of the landfarm began in 1990 and post-closure care began in 1996.

**If DTSC renews the Permit, Chevron will be allowed to continue to store and treat hazardous waste and continue post-closure care activities. This permit would be in effect for ten years.**

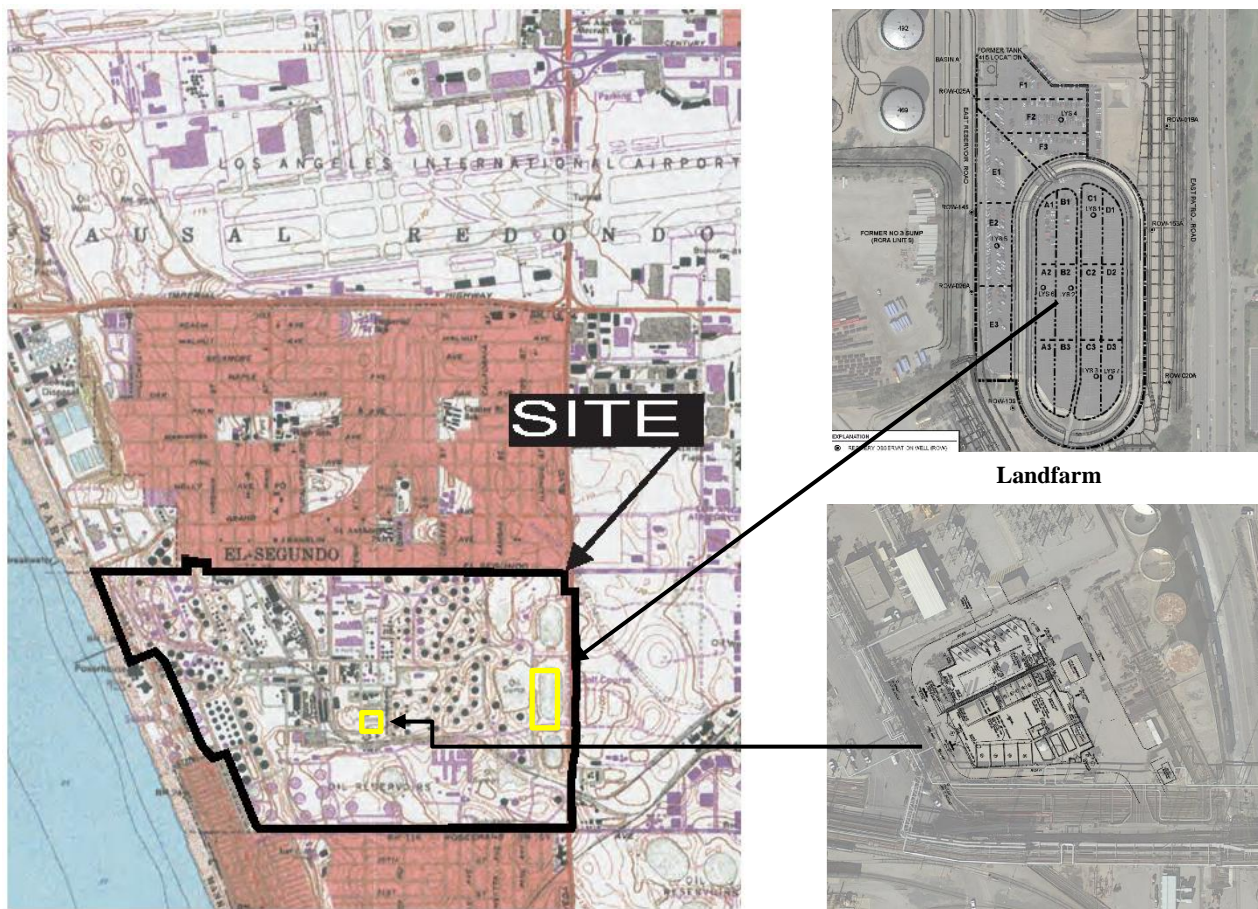
