Dear Mr. Rhodes:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made the final decision to renew the Hazardous Waste Facility Permit for the General Environmental Management of Rancho Cordova, LLC facility located at 11855 White Rock Road in Rancho Cordova, California, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66172.14. The final Permit allows for the continued processing of a wide variety of hazardous wastes for storage in tanks and containers (e.g., drums) and then for eventual disposal or recycling.

DTSC did not receive any comments on the Notice of Exemption for this permit decision, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Thus, DTSC has found that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.

As noted in the Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Decision, the Permit will become effective on April 23, 2007. Also noted therein, is a description of the 30-day permit appeal process.
