PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD STARTING: APRIL 27, 2018 – JUNE 11, 2018

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED? The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on the draft Hazardous Waste Treatment and Storage Permit and draft Negative Declaration for Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. Sacramento Facility (Facility), located at 6000 88th Street in Sacramento, California 95828.

The Facility offers services which include the accumulation and storage of spent materials collected from its customers. The waste is stored and shipped offsite to other Safety Kleen's recycle centers, an independent recycler or other permitted disposal facility. The Facility is not a disposal facility. The Facility is on a list enumerated under title 14 section 15072 of the Government Code.

The Facility has requested renewal of the current permitted units. In addition, the Facility is requesting authorization to make the following changes to the current operations at the site:

- Construction of four aboveground storage tanks for storage and transfer of used oil, spent antifreeze, and oily waste water;
- Store up to 10,560 gallons of hazardous waste in containers in an additional area located in the main warehouse building onsite.

If granted, the draft Permit will allow the Facility to continue its operations under the DTSC-issued permit. A permit enables DTSC to effectively regulate the hazardous waste management activities at facilities. Permits are developed after DTSC's detailed technical review of the permit application, and are intended to ensure that facilities operate in a manner that protects human health and the environment.

DTSC will accept public comments for the draft Permit and draft Negative Declaration during the public comment period starting **April 27, 2018 – June 11, 2018**. At the Public Meeting, there will be a question and answer session regarding the project. The Public Hearing will be formally convened to only accept public comments.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): Under CEQA, DTSC must evaluate whether the activities to be regulated by the Permit may have any significant impacts on human health and the environment. As part of this

evaluation, DTSC prepared an Initial Study and determined that issuance of the permit would not cause significant impacts to the environment. DTSC prepared a draft Negative Declaration. The Initial Study and Negative Declaration will be available for public comment during the comment period.
