45-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD – May 3 through June 18, 2018

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a proposed Hazardous Waste Permit renewal for Southern California Gas Company, Olympic Hazardous Waste Management Facility (SoCal Gas), located at 2424 E. Olympic Blvd., Los Angeles, California 90021.

DTSC is the state agency responsible for regulating the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. If approved, the renewed permit would allow the SoCal Gas facility to continue to operate the existing hazardous waste facility that currently stores wastes containing PCBs and other contaminated equipment and materials that are generated from off-site activities. DTSC has performed a review of the proposed draft permit renewal as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant adverse effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Exemption in connection with this project
