NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY POST-CLOSURE PERMIT DECISION

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is providing this Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Post-Closure Permit Decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Post-Closure Permit (Final Permit) to the following facility:

Westside Disposal Facility
N1/2 of the SE1/4 of Section 25 of
Township 31 South, Range 22 East,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian,
Fellows, California 93224
EPA ID Number: CAT080010283

The Westside Disposal Facility submitted a Revised Permit Application to DTSC in March 2017. The Final Permit authorizes Westside Disposal Facility to conduct post-closure care activities for two closed hazardous waste management units.

On March 31, 2017, DTSC published a public notice in Daily Midway Driller, regarding Westside Disposal Facility Post-Closure permit renewal. DTSC held a 45-day public comment period from March 31, 2017 through May 19, 2017 for the Draft Hazardous Waste Post Closure Permit (Draft Permit). DTSC did not receive comments requesting a change in the draft permit, nor were there changes from the draft to final permit decision. DTSC did not hold a public hearing to receive comments on the Draft Permit, nor received any request for a public hearing. Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14(b)(3), the Final Permit is effective June 12, 2017 and has an expiration date of June 11, 2027.

DTSC has determined this Final Permit is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 14, Section 15061(b)(3). DTSC has prepared a Notice of Exemption for this Final Permit to comply with the CEQA which states that renewal of the Facility's Post-Closure Permit will not have significant impacts to human health or the environment. DTSC will file a CEQA Notice

of Exemption (NOE) with the State of California, Office of Planning and Research, State Clearinghouse.
