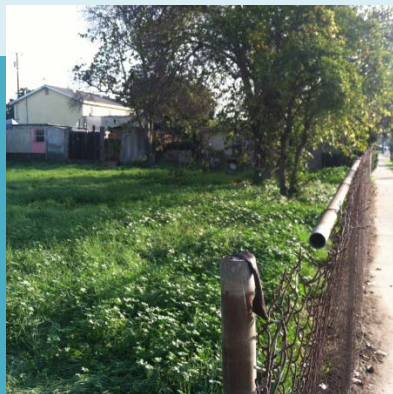
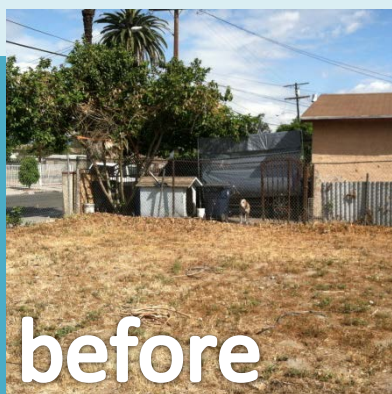
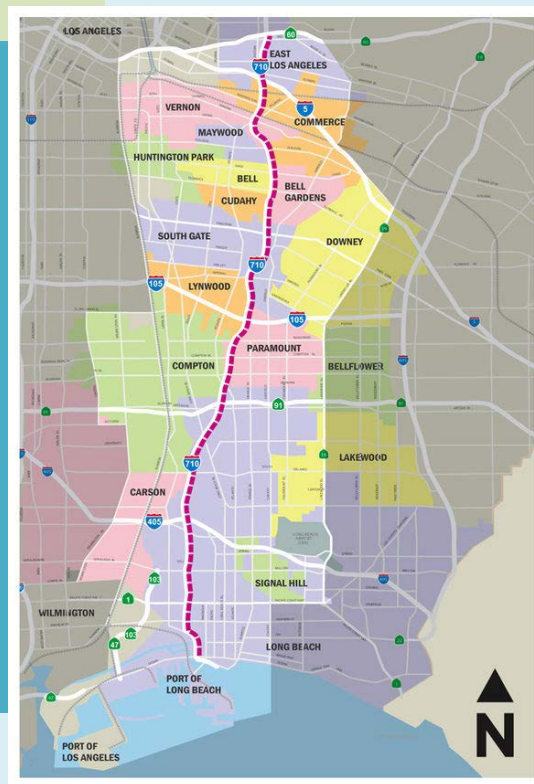




I-710 Corridor Environmental Assessment Opportunity

The California EPA Department of Toxic Substance Control (DTSC) has received a Community-Wide Brownfields Assessment grant from US EPA to perform environmental assessments. We are looking for properties along the I-710 Corridor that are underutilized, but can be developed.

DTSC's goal is to use our environmental, technical, and regulatory expertise to conduct environmental assessments in partnership with local agencies and non-profit organizations to put brownfields into safe and productive use.



DTSC is currently seeking properties that meet the following criteria:

- High redevelopment potential
- Redevelopment is hampered due to known or perceived contamination
- Local agency/non-profit organization that has an existing partnership with property owner
- Local agency/non-profit organization has access to the property
