## Draft Response Plan Available for Review 3280 Scott at the Square, Santa Clara, California 95054 Public Comment Period: February 22, 2017 - March 23, 2017

**WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?** The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on a proposed cleanup plan, called the draft Response Plan for the 3280 Scott at the Square (Site) located at 3130 and 3200 Coronado Drive in Santa Clara, California 95054. The 6.3-acre Site consists of two parcels and seven office buildings, parking structure, and landscaped areas. Investigations found soil contaminated with arsenic and lead at elevated levels. Future site plans include redevelopment with two office buildings and a parking garage. DTSC would oversee the proposed cleanup of contamination at the Site. The draft Response Plan proposes to consolidate the contaminated soil beneath the parking structure or "cap" contaminated soil in-place beneath buildings, parking structures, parking lots, or two feet of clean soil in landscaped areas. This response action would allow for unrestricted land use across all areas of the Site outside of the capped areas. A land use covenant would be required to restrict land use in the capped areas.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA):** The City of Santa Clara prepared a Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) in 2009 along with Addendums No. 1 and No. 4 to address the potential environmental impacts from the cleanup and development project at the Site. DTSC intends to rely on the City's FEIR and Addendums No. 1 and No. 4 to comply with CEQA. These documents can be found at the City of Santa Clara's Planning Division office.
