

CONSENT FOR ACCESS TO PROPERTY

On behalf of the Cabazon Band of Mission Indians (Cabazon), and pursuant to the following terms and conditions, I hereby give consent to and authorize the California Environmental Protection Agency and its Boards, Departments and Offices, including the Department of Toxic Substances Control; the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery; and their officers, employees, contractors and other duly authorized representatives (hereafter the "Authorized Parties"), to enter and have access to the Property located at the address indicated above for the following purposes:

To survey the entire premises, including buildings and fixtures, of the WEI Facility located at the Property. The survey will include: observation of physical conditions and processes; taking of photographs and video; reviewing and copying of records, reports and other information provided to the Authorized Parties by WEI only; sampling of the soil, air, water, groundwater and any other material or waste on the premises, including material/waste on vehicles on the premises.

The Cabazon also agree to provide the Authorized Parties the following documents for review only (without copying) on its Property to the extent that such documents are in the Cabazon's control or possession, except for documents or information that are trade secrets or confidential business information, covered by the attorney-client privilege, or other privileges under applicable law:

a. Copies of all tribal facility assessment reports and other documents regarding the operations, management and facility design of the WEI Facility;

b. Copies of all facility assessment reports and any other documents, records and correspondence received from the United States Environmental Protection Agency related to WEI and/or the WEI Facility;

c. Copies of Cabazon's environmental and other regulatory rules, requirements and conditions governing the operations, management and facility design of the WEI Facility; and

d. Copies of any and all reports, documents, records submitted by WEI and/or the WEI Facility to Cabazon.

This Consent for Access to Property is not intended to, and shall not be construed to, impose any contractual or legal obligations on the Cabazon to provide access to the Authorized Parties for any purpose or to provide any documents to the Authorized Parties.

Nothing contained herein shall grant, or be construed to grant, the State of California, the California Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Toxic Substances Control, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, or any other Department, Board, Office or Agency thereof, any jurisdiction over the Cabazon Band of Mission Indians or the Cabazon Indian Reservation, or over any other Indian tribe or Indian reservation in the State of California.

The Authorized Parties shall notify the Cabazon Environmental Department at least twenty four (24) hours prior to each entry onto the Property.

The access provided herein shall be effective upon execution of this document and shall remain in effect for 60 days from the effective date or until September 30, 2011, whichever is later, unless revoked as provided herein. Access shall be available from 5:00 AM to 8:00 PM each day. The Authorized Parties may return and enter the Property for further survey, sampling, review and copying of documents provided to the Authorized Parties by WEI only, and for any other activity authorized herein prior to revocation of this access. The consent to access the Property and to provide documents is given voluntarily. This consent may be revoked at any time by giving written notice thereof to the California Environmental Protection Agency.

The access provided herein is based on the understanding that the Authorized Parties will share with Cabazon their work product and assessment generated or made as a result of gaining access to the Property under this Consent for Access to Property within ninety (90) days after termination of the period of access granted herein. The Authorized Parties reserve their rights to withhold records that are exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act (Gov. Code, §6250 et seq.), including records covered by the attorney-client privilege and other privileges under applicable law.

I certify that I am the authorized agent for the Cabazon Band of Mission Indians and that I have the authority to grant such access.
