Subject: Exide Technologies Closure Review Dated May 2015

Dear Mr. Stratman,

The City of Vernon Health & Environmental Control Department oversees the CUPA program which includes the use and storage of hazardous materials/wastes; the above ground storage tank program; and Proposition 65 postings. In addition, we also regulate the stormwater management program and the local enforcement agency solid waste program (waste processing facility) within the City of Vernon.

We have reviewed the subject closure report, and would like to make the following comments for correction and inclusion before DTSC notices the Closure Plan for public comment:

Section 2.6.3: states "Other permits relating to Hazardous Waste Storage or Treatment" and should include the statement, *All permits shall remain in effect and current as long as inventories and materials remain on-site, and a closure letter is issued by the City.*

Section 3.4.6.4: states "a Building Demolition permit will be obtained from the City of Vernon Development Services Department . . ." which should be changed to *Public Works, Water & Development Dept.*


Section 3.4.6.5: states "a City of Vernon Health & Environmental Control Department permit will be obtained for any soil boring exceeding 50 feet below grade" and should be changed to include *any established/proposed monitoring well, any soil boring exceeding 50 feet below grade, and any ground water monitoring well.*

It should also be noted that the City of Vernon (COV) will issue a concurrence closure letter after DTSC has finalized and issued its closure letter and Exide has met all of the closure requirements for the City, including the submission of all demolition diversion/recycling reports,

closure documents, and review fees (COV fees include: \$976 for annual review of documents, \$268 for final closure letter.)
