NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY POST-CLOSURE PERMIT
DECISION FOR THE FORMER INTERNATIONAL LIGHT METALS FACILITY, 19200 S.
WESTERN AVENUE, TORRANCE, LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, EPA ID

To Interested Parties:

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made a final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Post Closure Permit for the Former International Light Metals facility located at 19200 S. Western Avenue, Torrance, California. The Final Post Closure Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, sections 66264.112 and 66271.14.

In accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.42(c), DTSC sent a notice of the Post Closure Permit to all persons on the facility mailing list and appropriate units of State and local government. Public notices were placed in the Daily Breeze and a radio announcement was also made on KIIS FM 102.7 on December 5, 2012. The public comment period for the draft Post Closure Permit started on December 5, 2012 and ended on January 25, 2013. A Public Meeting was held on January 8, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the Katy Geissert Civic Center Library, 3301 Torrance Blvd., Torrance, California 90503. DTSC received a comment from the community by an e-mail. DTSC responded to the e-mail.

DTSC will also file a Notice of Exemption for the Post Closure Permit to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act.

The final Permit is issued by DTSC on March 5, 2013, 2013 in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14. The final Permit becomes effective on April 8, 2013. The final Permit may be appealed in accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the draft Permit may petition the DTSC to review any condition of the permit decision.

Any person who failed to file comments on the draft Permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft Permit to the final Permit.

The 30-day period within which a person may request review begins on March 5, 2013 and ends April 5, 2013. The petition must be sent to:

The appeals can also be filed electronically at appeals@dtsc.ca.gov but signed original must be sent by mail, postmarked by the end of the due date April 5, 2013. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

- 1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
- 2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should review.
