Dear Mr. Owens:

The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control has made a final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Post Closure Permit for the Former International Light Metals facility located at 19200 S. Western Avenue, Torrance, California.

In accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.42(c), DTSC sent a notice of the draft Post Closure Permit to all persons on the facility mailing list and appropriate units of State and local government. Public notices were placed in the Daily Breeze and a radio announcement was also made on KIIS FM 102.7 on December 5, 2012. The public comment period for the draft Post Closure Permit started on December 5, 2012 and ended on January 25, 2013. A Public Meeting was held on January 8, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the Katy Geissert Civic Center Library, 3301 Torrance Blvd., Torrance, California 90503.

DTSC received a comment from the community by an e-mail. A response to the e-mail comment is attached.

DTSC will also file a Notice of Exemption for the Post Closure Permit to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act.

The final Permit is issued by DTSC on March 5, 2013 with the effective date of April 8, 2013 in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14.
