



NOTICE OF A PROPOSED PERMIT MODIFICATION

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on a proposed Class 3 Permit Modification for the following hazardous waste management facility:

Kettleman Hills Facility
Chemical Waste Management, Incorporated
35251 Old Skyline Road
Kettleman City, California 93239

The permit modification, if approved, will modify the Closure Plan for the landfill unit B-19 which currently holds both hazardous waste and non-hazardous waste (garbage) in separated areas. This modification to the closure plan allows for the safe operation of a bioreactor in the garbage part of the landfill. The bioreactor would add liquids to speed up the breakdown of garbage.

As required by California law, DTSC must review all permit modification requests and make a decision based on the merits. On this proposed permit modification, the facility conducted a public comment period and held a public meeting on January 4, 2007. With this notice, DTSC starts an additional public comment period for 45 days.
