The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is approving the Closure Demonstration Report, dated December 2006 for the Wastewater Retention Basins at the Southern California Edison, Highgrove Generating Station (SCE). SCE is located at 12700 Taylor Street, Grand Terrace, California.

On January 2, 2007, DTSC issued a public notice to receive comments on the proposed Closure Demonstration Report for the SCE closure and corresponding Notice of Exemption in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act. The 30-day comment period began on January 2, 2007 and ended on February 1, 2007. A notice announcing the public comment period for the proposed Closure Demonstration Report and a proposed Notice of Exemption prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) was also published in the Press-Enterprise, Inland Empire Newspaper on January 2, 2007.

DTSC received comments from two residents during the public comment period. DTSC prepared a Response to Comments and determined that no change to the CDR is needed as a result of the received comments. A copy of the Response to Comments was sent to those who either provided comments or requested this information.

The Final Closure Demonstration Report package, including DTSC's final Closure Demonstration Report decision, Notice of Exemption, and Closure Certification Acknowledgement, is located at the Grand Terrace Branch Library, at 22795 Barton Way, Grand Terrace, CA 92313. The Closure Demonstration Report proposed the closure of the Wastewater Retention Basins without any further action. With the approval of the Closure Demonstration
