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NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY POST CLOSURE PERMIT DECISION JUNE 23, 2016

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations (Cal. Code of Regs.), title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Post-Closure Permit Decision (Notice) for the following hazardous waste facility:

TFX Aviation, Incorporated
3085 Old Conejo Road
Newbury Park, California 91320
EPA ID NO. CAD008383127

DTSC previously issued a Hazardous Waste Facility Post-Closure Permit for the above Facility on October 7, 2005. TFX Aviation, Incorporated submitted its permit renewal application on March 12, 2015. Upon completion of review of the application, DTSC prepared and issued a draft Permit on April 16, 2016 for public comment. A public comment period was held from April 16, 2016 to June 3, 2016. DTSC announced the public comment period in community notices mailed on April 14, 2016, and a public notice was published in a newspaper publication, radio advertisement and DTSC website postings on or about April 16, 2016. A public hearing was held on May 18, 2016 at 6:00 pm. Only 2 people attended the public hearing. DTSC received 1 public comment submittal during the public comment period. DTSC has prepared a Response to Comments document (RTC) and made changes to the Draft Permit. The RTC and a copy of the final Permit are available for formal public review at the repositories listed at the end of the Notice.

In accordance with the requirements of Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. and the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, concurrent with this decision DTSC will file a Notice of Exemption with the State of California, Office of Planning and Research, State Clearinghouse.

The Final Hazardous Waste Post-Closure Facility Permit will become effective on July 23, 2016, unless a review is requested, through the appeal process, pursuant to the Cal. Code of Regs., title 22, section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the draft permit may petition DTSC to review any condition of the permit decision. Any

person who failed to file comments on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft permit to the final permit. The petition must include a statement of the reasons supporting the review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period to the extent required by the regulations and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding or fact conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review.
