HAZARDOUS WASTES OF CONCERN TRANSPORTERS

California Code of Regulations, Title 22, section 66261.111 defines hazardous wastes of concern (HWC) as wastes that fall into at least one of the following United States Department of Transportation hazard classes:

- Explosives (Divisions 1.1, 1.2, or 1.3)
- Poisonous Gases (Division 2.3)
- Poisonous Substances (Division 6.1, packing groups I or II)

Health and Safety Code, section 25169.7 requires hazardous waste transporters to submit a disclosure statement and pass a criminal background check (if applicable) before transporting HWC.

If you **do not transport HWC**, you are not required to submit a disclosure statement.

If you **intend to transport HWC**, you are required to submit a disclosure statement and pass a criminal background check (if applicable) **BEFORE** transporting HWC.

If you are **renewing you HWC transporter status**, filing a new disclosure statement is not necessary, unless information has changed.

- **ANY** change of information on you disclosure statement, requires you notify the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) of the updated information **IN WRITING**.
- HWC transporters must submit the notification to the disclosure statement coordinator **WITHIN 30 DAYS** of the change.
