## DRAFT STATEMENT OF BASIS FOR A CORRECTIVE ACTION COMPLETE DETERMINATION FOR THE FORMER SAFETY-KLEEN SYSTEMS FACILITY

### Public Comment Period: January 15, 2013 to March 01, 2013

**What's Being Proposed?** The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites the public to comment on a proposed Corrective Action Complete Determination (CAD), under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), for the former Safety-Kleen Systems facility located at 2576 Mercantile Drive in Rancho Cordova, California (Site). The Site was a hazardous waste facility that stored and recycled hazardous waste. In June 1993, DTSC completed the RCRA Facility Assessment for the Site and identified six former solid waste management units where hazardous waste was handled or stored, and one area of concern. The contaminants of concern were total petroleum hydrocarbons and volatile organic compounds in the soils on the site, including; toluene, ethylbenzene, xylenes, tetrachlorethene and cis-1,2-dichloroethene.

Information supporting the proposed CAD is contained in a document called a Statement of Basis, which summarizes the site investigations and the reasons DTSC is proposing a CAD for the Site.

**How Do I Participate?** DTSC encourages you to take this opportunity to provide comments on the CAD during a 45-day public comment period from **January 15, 2013** through **March 01, 2013**. All comments must be postmarked or received by **March 01, 2013**. Send comments to:
