Green Ribbon Science Panel Webinar and Conference Call Meeting June 25, 2014, 9:00 am – 12:30 pm, PDT

Please join the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) as we convene a Webinar and Conference Call meeting of the Green Ribbon Science Panel (GRSP or Panel), on June 25, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Pacific Time. The public is invited to attend and address the Panel on agenda items.

BACKGROUND

The GRSP was established by AB 1879 (Feuer, Chapter 559, Statutes of 2008) to act as a resource to the DTSC and the California Environmental Leadership Council. The GRSP will provide scientific and technical advice to DTSC as we strive to build a meaningful, practical, and defensible Safer Consumer Products program. The GRSP also provides advice and recommendations on a variety of other scientific and technical matters related to green chemistry and chemicals policy and implementation strategies.

MEETING PURPOSE

The purpose of this meeting is to provide the GRSP a forum to discuss and advise DTSC about approaches to identify product categories in the 3-Year Priority Product Work Plan. The product categories in the 3-Year Priority Product Work Plan will guide DTSC in the upcoming years on the types of chemical-product combinations to evaluate as potential Priority Products.

The meeting will be conducted via Webinar and Conference Call on Wednesday, June 25, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Pacific Time. GRSP members will participate over the Webinar and telephone from the various designated and publicly accessible locations listed below.
