Briefing Webinar Meeting

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is convening a Briefing Webinar Meeting of the Green Ribbon Science Panel (GRSP), on Wednesday, January 29, 2014, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Pacific Time.

The purpose of this Briefing Webinar Meeting is to provide the GRSP a forum to clarify and discuss informational materials germane to the GRSP's advisory capacity to DTSC. The Webinar will cover:

- Informational materials related to the goals and operational aspects of the GRSP, and
- A briefing on the Safer Consumer Products regulations.

The GRSP was established by AB 1879 (FEUER) (Chapter 559, Statutes of 2008) to act as a resource to the DTSC and the California Environmental Leadership Council. The GRSP provides advice and recommendations on a variety of scientific and technical matters related to developing green chemistry and chemicals policy recommendations and implementation strategies.
