Important Information on the Riverside Ag Park Site

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has posted a new document, **Zero Detections of PCBs in Air: Riverside Agricultural Park** to the DTSC website. This document provides laboratory data for polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) analysis of air samples collected at the Riverside Ag Park from August 22, 2016 through September 21, 2016 under the direction of DTSC. To date, PCB concentrations have not been detected in any of the air samples collected from the downwind monitoring stations located at the Riverside Ag Park property boundary. DTSC is providing lead regulatory oversight for the removal of soil contaminated with PCBs.

Additionally, please note that based on feedback of the Community Work Group (Work Group), the Work Group public meetings scheduled for Thursday December 15th and Thursday February 9th **will be rescheduled**. Details on the new meeting dates will be provided in an upcoming e-mail soon.
