## DRAFT REMOVAL ACTION WORKPLAN FOR THE LANDING-NEW MILL AREA FORMERLY KNOWN AS ROSEBURG LUMBER MILL

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: APRIL 12, 2016 - MAY 11, 2016**

**WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?** TRC has prepared the draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW) for the Landing-New Mill Area, formerly known as Roseburg Lumber Mill located west of South Mt. Shasta Boulevard near the intersection of Church Street in the City of Mt. Shasta, Siskiyou County, California 96067 (Site). The draft RAW will address cleanup of Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH), Pentachlorophenol (PCP), Polychlorinated biphenyl (PCBs), and Dioxins/Furans in soil from past operations.

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will oversee the project proposed in the draft RAW. We invite you to review and comment on the draft RAW, which describes the investigations carried out at the Site and the proposed remedy.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT:** In Compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC conducted an Initial Study that determined the proposed project along with mitigation measures would not have a significant environmental impact. DTSC used the Mitigated Negative Declaration with the appropriate document to prepare the CEQA. DTSC welcomes comments on the adequacy of the analysis contained in the Initial Study and proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration.

**HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?** DTSC will accept public comments on the draft RAW for the Site during the public comment period **April 12 - May 11, 2016**. All comments must be received by **May 11, 2016**. Send all comments to:
