### Placement of soil borings and installation of soil vapor extraction wells – starting April 18, 2011

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will oversee drilling activities to collect soil samples, install 44 soil vapor extraction wells to remove soil vapors and to abandon 62 monitoring wells. You will see workers in safety gear placing the borings, installing wells, destroying other wells and setting up fencing, trailers and air monitoring equipment.

We will take the following actions during this process to make sure that you are safe and to control dust:

- All vehicles will maintain slow speeds while on the property
- Workers will spray the drilling and other work areas with clean water to control dust and vapor

Work hours are from 7 A.M. to 5 P.M. for about six weeks.
