You may comment on a Proposed Remedy for soil/groundwater at the Sacramento Railyards

Comment Period: February 19, 2013 - March 20, 2013

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on a proposed cleanup plan for the Central Shops area and the South Plume Study Area of the Sacramento Railyards project. You may also come to the **public meeting** on this proposal scheduled for **March 12** starting at **6:30 p.m.** in the Stanford Gallery, 111 "P" Street, First Floor, Sacramento CA 95814. You may park on the street and in the nearby Sacramento City parking lot.

The Draft Remedial Action Plan (Draft RAP) addresses impacted soil, groundwater, and potential soil vapor issues that allows for the planned land uses as decided by the City of Sacramento.

The public comment period begins February 19, 2013, and ends March 20, 2013. You may send all public comments in writing to Ruth Cayabyab, Project Manager, DTSC, 8800 Cal Center Drive, Sacramento, CA 95826 or by e-mail to Ruth.Cayabyab@dtsc.ca.gov and must be postmarked or delivered by March 20, 2013.

The City of Sacramento, as Lead Agency under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), prepared the Final Railyards Specific Plan Environmental Impact Report (FEIR). DTSC considered the effects described in the City's FEIR and concluded that approval of the Draft RAP would not result in significant impacts to the environment. DTSC has prepared an Addendum to the FEIR having determined this as the appropriate document under CEQA. Upon approval of the Draft RAP, DTSC will file a Notice of Determination to start the 30-day statute of limitations on court challenges to the approval under CEQA.
