SITE INVESTIGATION/CLEANUP DOCUMENTS

- DTSC received a monitoring report dated November 1, 2004, for California Regional Water Quality Control Board (CRWQCB) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. CAG918001. The report describes ground water treatment discharge activities for the period from August 23, 2004 to September 30, 2004.
- DTSC received the Third Quarter 2004 Groundwater Monitoring Report dated November 1, 2004. The report presents the findings of the groundwater monitoring event conducted for the period from July 21 through 23, and July 26 through 29, 2004, at the Wyle Laboratories facility.
- DTSC has held discussions with Wyle regarding acceptable investigation and cleanup strategies and priorities.

INVESTIGATION/CLEANUP FIELD WORK

- At the home on Golden West Lane where TCE was detected in in-door air, investigation has begun to evaluate activities to mitigate potential in-door air infiltration into the home. Temporary ventilation system enhancements have been made and additional indoor air samples were collected. The modification is to test the amount of air brought into the home and if it will achieve reducing exposure levels. If the test is successful, a separate and new system will be installed.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

- DTSC set up an interagency meeting for November 12, 2004 with city, county, and state officials, as well as the CAG chair, to continue collaborative discussions that began at the National Association of City and County Health Organizations conference on October 25.
- DTSC is hosting a public meeting on November 29, 2004 to update the community on the Wyle project.
