**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: May 20, 2010 through June 21, 2010**

**WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?** The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a proposed Interim Measures Work Plan (IM Work Plan) for the former Printronix/Schlage Lock Facility (Facility). The primary objective of the IM Work Plan is to present interim measures that will remediate onsite soil contamination at the Facility. Since the 1960s, the Facility has been used for light industrial use. The Schlage Lock Company occupied the site from 1968 to 1977. Printronix occupied the site from 1980 to 1994. The site is currently occupied by DHL, a parcel delivery service. In 2006, Printronix and Schlage Lock Company entered into a legally binding agreement with DTSC to investigate contamination at the Facility. The proposed interim measures consist of conducting a soil vapor survey, performing a Dual-Phase Extraction (DPE) system pilot test, and running a full scale DPE system. The data from the soil vapor survey will be used to determine the position of the extraction well for DPE system pilot test. The results of the pilot test will be used to determine the positioning of the extraction wells for the full scale DPE system. The DPE system will operate until soil contamination has been remediated. As required by California Law, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed cleanup plan in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on the review, DTSC has determined that the proposed interim measure will not have any significant adverse effects on public health or the environment, and proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption (NOE) in connection with this project. The proposed CEQA NOE is available for public review during the 30-day comment period.

DTSC encourages you to review and provide comments on the proposed Interim Measures Work Plan during the Public Comment Period running from **May 20, 2010 – June 21, 2010**. DTSC will consider all comments before finalizing its decision to approve the Interim Measures Work Plan.
