EMERGENCY PERMIT NAVAL AIR FACILITY EL CENTRO NAF EL CENTRO, EL CENTRO

On Jun 26, 2018, Naval Air Facility 1065 3rd Street, EL Centro 92243 (NAF) requested an Emergency Permit from the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for the treatment of hazardous waste. In this case, the treatment of hazardous waste involves the open detonation of 1 cartridge blank 40 mm, 2 caps blasting electric, 3 caps blasting nonelectric, 3 cord detonating 6 in, 75 ammunition cartridge various calibers ball, 1 simulator pyrotechnic hand grenade M116A1, 3 simulator pyrotechnic ground burst L594, 1 flare marine marker, 2 ammunition cartridge 0.5 caliber ball M2, 5 squib electric, 1 bomb high explosive U.S. 1001b MK1 Mod4, 1 grenade hand high explosive/fragmentation, 1 grenade hand practice, 1 warhead high explosive 5" with burster adapter, 15 cartridge high explosive 20 mm from Navy training on base. The Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Mobile Unit will conduct this treatment. These items are located at Naval Base Coronado EOD safe holding area awaiting transport to the established EOD disposal site on NAF El Centro Bombing range.

These items have been determined to be unsafe for transportation and require treatment by detonation at NAF El Centro. The treatment will be conducted at NAF El Centro Bombing range. No hazardous waste is expected to be generated from the disposal by detonation. However, if required, any hazardous waste generated must be moved to an authorized unit for storage and shipped in accordance with the applicable regulatory and statutory requirements. DTSC has determined that these items pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment and therefore an emergency permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from **July 18, 2018 - October 15, 2018**. The detonation must take place within that time frame. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse on **July 17, 2018**.
