

### Examples of Situations That DO NOT Require an Emergency Permit

1. During excavation at a construction site, an unexploded munition item is discovered. The site is evacuated and a bomb squad is called in and determines the item is unstable and cannot be moved. The item is detonated in place.
2. A tanker truck carrying used oil or other hazardous waste is damaged and is leaking or threatening to leak. The used oil must be transferred immediately to another truck to contain or avoid a spill.
3. A suspicious item found in a public place posing probable harm to human health or environment and needs treatment onsite.
