The mission of DTSC is to protect California's people and environment from harmful effects of toxic substances by restoring contaminated resources, enforcing hazardous waste laws, reducing hazardous waste generation, and encouraging the manufacture of chemically safer products.

SITE MAINTENANCE Former PureGro Facility 1025 River Drive, Brawley, California

Site History:

- Site is the Former PureGro Company facility
- **1940's:** Chemical mixing and distribution of dry fertilizer
- **1970s:** Pesticide formulation process ended.
- **2001:** Demolition and removal of buildings and equipment completed
- **2004:** DTSC issued a Consent Order to PureGro to investigate and remediate the Site
- **2006:** 15,000 cubic yards of soil were removed from the adjacent lot east of site and stored as a stockpile within the fenced area onsite
- The Site & stockpile have been regularly inspected, monitored. New stockpile covers have been applied every 2 years since 2006
- These activities will continue until a final remedy is selected & approved by DTSC

What is the work?

Routine site maintenance activities includes:

- Install erosion control blankets on the stockpile
- Apply a material called Soil Sement® to prevent dust blowing off the Site
- Remove weeds, trash & graffiti, as needed, and replace signage
- Annual groundwater monitoring

What is the purpose of the work?

- Prevent dust generation from the Site & stockpile
- Annual sampling of groundwater

When will you see work?

Work is scheduled to begin the week of May 21, 2018 and be completed in 4 to 5 days. Work hours are between 6 am and 6 pm.

Where will you see work?

- 1025 River Drive, Brawley, California

What work will you see?

- Small team of workers
- Construction vehicles
- Installation of erosion control blankets
- Groundwater sampling

Who will do the work?

- Environmental contractors will do the stockpile maintenance, apply dust suppressant (Soil Sement®), and sample groundwater wells
- DTSC will oversee the work being done

What Safety Measures will be in place?

- Continual dust monitoring
- Monitoring of wind conditions
- Water trucks to reduce / prevent dust generated during work
- All workers will follow a Health and Safety Plan

How will the work impact you?

- All streets will be open as usual
- Work will be completed within the boundaries of the Site
- Work hours between 6 am and 6 pm
