DTSC Approves First 5-Year Review of the Remedy for the Reichelt Site, 521/551W Gertrude Avenue in

Richmond

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces the completion of the first Five—Year Review Report for the Reichelt Site. The Reichelt Site (Site) is located at 521 and 551 W Gertrude Avenue in Richmond, California 94801.

At least one automobile dismantling business operated at this Site for about 45 years. As part of the cleanup, DTSC placed restrictions on the property. DTSC and the property owner signed an agreement known as a Land Use Covenant (LUC) in 2008. The LUC does not allow homes to be built on the Site. The Site has lead in the soil above levels safe for homes. Also, the LUC restricts any movement of soil without a DTSC approved Soils Management Plan. This remedy requires annual inspections.

We decided that this remedy remains fully protective of human health. Also, we found that the cleanup continues to protect the environment. To make these decisions, DTSC reviewed all of the annual reports from the owner. We also inspected the Site.
