**SITE INVESTIGATION/CLEANUP**

- We have received two of three access agreements to conduct indoor air sampling at the homes on El Paso Road, where previous air sampling was done by a private contractor hired by the residents. The sampling is anticipated to be done this week. One resident has not given access to Wyle to date. The previous sampling done privately showed trace levels of TCE (trichloroethene), DCE (dichloroethene) and vinyl chloride in the air inside one or more of the three homes. DTSC is requiring Wyle to conduct this indoor air sampling as part of the boundary reassessment, due to the rise of groundwater levels.
- Installation of the cleanup system on Wyle northwestern boundary on Golden West starts this week. DTSC approved the cleanup plan on September 27, 2005, after a 30-day formal public comment period. The cleanup includes putting small soil vapor extraction (SVE) wells at the cul-de-sac of Golden West Lane, and in the driveways of three residences. The SVE system will use a vacuum unit to pull the chemical vapors from the soil near the cul-de-sac of Golden West Lane. These vapors come from contaminated groundwater that has moved offsite from Wyle. The chemical vapors will be put through carbon filters, and the cleaned air will be discharged into the open. (The air will be tested to make sure it is clean before it is discharged.)

Ongoing Remedial Investigation activities:

**Last week**

Onsite:

- Completed soil sampling in Area A and grab groundwater sampling in Areas A and I.

Offsite:

- Completed the chemical inventory at 1611 and 1591 El Paso Drive. This was done in preparation for the indoor air sampling.

**Sampling planned for this week**

Onsite:

- Trenching and pipe installation for cleanup system near Wyle northwest area.

Offsite:

- Install soil vapor extraction wells at 2270, 2281, 2297 Golden West Lane and at Golden West Lane cul-de-sac.
- Indoor air sampling at 1611 and 1591 El Paso Drive.
