WHY THIS NOTICE? On March 22, 2018, Allergan Inc. requested an Emergency Permit from the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 2525 Dupont Drive, Irvine, CA 92612. The items to be treated include; Tetrahydrofuran, Diethyl Ether, Tert Butyl Methyl Ether, Ethyl Vinyl Ether, Ethylene Glycol Dimethyl Ether, Acetaldehyde, Diethylene Glycol Monomethyl Ether, 1,4 Dioxane, 1-Phenyl-1H Tetrazole, 1-Hydroxybenzotriazole, Diphenylphosphoryl Azide, Tosyl Azide, Benzoyl Peroxide, 2,2 Azobisisobutyronitrile, Diazald, 3-Chloroperoxybenzoic Acid.

Clean Harbors Environmental Services has been contracted to conduct this treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from April 5, 2018 through June 4, 2018. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
