## Beckman Coulter Inc. Proposed Cleanup Plan, Fullerton, California PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: November 21, 2014 to January 9, 2015

### WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) requests the public to review a proposed plan to clean up contaminated soil, soil vapor and groundwater at the Beckman Coulter Inc. site (Site). The Site is located at 4300 North Harbor Boulevard, Fullerton, California. This cleanup plan, called a draft Corrective Measures Study (CMS), describes the environmental investigations, results, and recommendations to clean up contaminated soil, soil vapor and groundwater at the Site.

### CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

The City of Fullerton (City) and DTSC evaluated any possible environmental impacts associated with the proposed cleanup of this Site, as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). City has prepared an Environmental Impact Report (EIR), Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) and Addendum for the Site. DTSC considered the EIR, IS/MND and Addendum and do not expect the proposed cleanup will have significant impacts on human health and the environment. The findings are available for public review in the information repositories listed below.

### HOW TO PARTICIPATE

We encourage your participation. Comments on the draft CMS and associated CEQA documents may be submitted in writing to William Jeffers, DTSC Project Manager. All emailed or written comments must be received or postmarked no later than **January 9, 2015**. All comments will be carefully reviewed before making a final decision on the draft CMS. Notification of the final decision and a copy of DTSC's response to comments will be provided to those who submit comments and their contact information.
