PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: March 7, 2006 to April 21, 2006

WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a proposed Hazardous Waste Permit renewal for the hazardous waste facility (Building 3458) at Naval Station San Diego (NAVSTA). Naval Station San Diego is located just south of downtown San Diego and adjacent to National City, California. The Environmental Protection Agency Identification Number is: CA 6170024289.

DTSC is the state agency responsible for regulating the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. If approved, the renewed permit would allow the facility to continue to operate the existing hazardous waste drum storage, consolidation and transfer activities at Building 3458. As part of the permit process, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed draft permit renewal in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant adverse effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption in connection with this project.
