What is the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and what do we do?

DTSC is part of the California Environmental Protection Agency. We regulate the storage and handling of hazardous materials. DTSC will ensure that the environmental investigations and response action at the former Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation (Northrop Grumman) Facility will be done according to the standards of the State of California.

Northrop Grumman Site History:

From the early 1940's until mid-2000, Northrop Grumman operated an industrial aerospace facility on approximately 321 acres. The Site is in the City of Hawthorne, Los Angeles County and split by the Dominguez Flood Control Channel and Crenshaw Boulevard. The parcels are divided into East and West portions of the property. Interim Measures have been proposed for the West portion, located at 1 Northrop Avenue, Hawthorne, California (Site). A Preliminary Assessment identified seven (7) Solid Waste Management Units, and three (3) Areas of Concern.

What Is Going On?

Northrop Grumman under the oversight of DTSC has investigated to determine the extent of contamination at the Site and look at appropriate ways to clean it up. The overall goal is to clean up areas of the Site where past waste handling operations or production resulted in chemical releases to soil and groundwater that may present an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment. Interim Measures have been underway since 2003, including four that have been completed and two that are ongoing.

Northrop Grumman is proposing additional Interim Measures as part of addressing the cleanup of the release of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in groundwater at the Site.
