Project Description:

The project involves DTSC's approval of the Work Plan for groundwater interim measures at the Univar USA, Inc. (Univar) Bonnie Beach facility. The Univar facility was formerly the location of a hazardous materials storage and hazardous waste storage and treatment facility. Univar has been completing corrective action at the site since 1995. The characterization of the site has disclosed sub-surface contamination of soil, soil vapor and groundwater by chlorinated solvents. The groundwater plume from the site has migrated off-site to the southwest.

The purpose of the groundwater interim measure is to control the groundwater plume at the site and prevent off-site migration of contaminated groundwater. The current proposed groundwater interim measures are limited to on-site and near site activities.

The groundwater interim measures will consist of groundwater pump-and treat with concurrent soil vapor extraction. The extracted groundwater will be treated in an air stripper and the combined air stripper effluent and soil vapor stream will be destroyed in the thermal oxidation unit. The treated vapor stream will be released to the atmosphere and the treated groundwater will be discharged to the sanitary sewer. The groundwater interim measure will replace an existing soil vapor interim measure at the site.

Finding Of Significant Effect On Environment: *(An Initial Study supporting this finding is attached.)*

Based on the findings of the Initial Study, DTSC finds that the implementation of the Work Plan for groundwater interim measures will not have a significant impact on human health or the environment.

Mitigation Measures:

No mitigation measures beyond those included in the Project Description are required to ensure that project impacts will be less than significant.
