Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration Checklist

To apply for a new registration or to renew your current registration as a hazardous waste transporter, you are required to submit the following documents:

□ <u>Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration Application</u> (DTSC Form 187) Note: An original "wet signature" is required on this form.

□ **Proof of Insurance** (NOTE: All insurance forms are required to have an original signature. Typed, digital, or facsimile signatures will result in a deficiency.)

Endorsement for Motor Carrier Policies of Insurance for Public Liability (MCS- 90) **OR** Motor Carrier Surety Bond for Public Liability (MCS-82)

AND

Certificate of Insurance for Public Liability Coverage (DTSC Form 8038) **OR** Certificate of Liability Insurance (COI) **OR** an ACORD Form

Note: A letter of Self-Insurance is an acceptable proof of insurance for Government agencies only.

□ Active EPA ID Number

If you do not have an EPA ID number, please visit the <u>Apply for a Hazardous Waste</u> <u>Identification Number</u> webpage. Please note, transporters of hazardous waste are required to have a permanent identification number.
