

## Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration Checklist Revision 5/2020

To apply for a new registration or to renew your current registration as a hazardous waste transporter, you are required to submit the following documents:

- [Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration Application \(DTSC Form 187\)](#)

Note: An original “wet signature” is required on this form.

- Proof of Insurance** (one of the following is required)
- Endorsement for Motor Carrier Policies of Insurance for Public Liability (MCS-90)
  - Motor Carrier Surety Bond for Public Liability (MCS-82)
  - [Certificate of Insurance for Public Liability Coverage \(DTSC Form 8038\)](#)
  - Letter of Self-Insurance (government agencies only)

- Active EPA ID Number** (one of the following is required)

If you have an EPA ID number already please do the following:

- Write the EPA ID number in box 8 on the Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration Application (DTSC Form 187).

If you do *not* have an EPA ID number, obtain one by submitting one of the following applications:

- To obtain a permanent *State* ID number submit the [Permanent State ID Number Application \(DTSC Form 1358\)](#)
- To obtain a permanent *federal* EPA ID number submit the [EPA Form 8700-12 – RCRA Subtitle C Site Identification Form](#)
