


In this regulatory action, the Department proposes to amend various sections in title 22, division 4.5, chapters 10, 11, and 23 of the California Code of Regulations to regulate photovoltaic (PV) modules as hazardous waste. By way of these amendments, the Department proposes to define PV modules, create exemptions to hazardous waste management requirements for these PV modules, and provide requirements for these exemptions.

OAL disapproves this regulatory action for the following reason(s):

The disapproved regulations fail to comply with the Clarity standard of Government Code section 11349.1. and fail to comply with the Consistency standard of Government Code section 11349.1. Further, the Department failed to follow the required procedure.

Within seven (7) calendar days of the date of this notice, the Office of Administrative Law will send the adopting agency a written decision detailing the reason(s) for disapproval of this regulatory filing. Pursuant to Government Code section 11349.4, the adopting agency may resubmit the regulation(s) within 120 calendar days of receipt of that written decision.
