

Chapter 40. Selection and Ranking Criteria for Hazardous
Waste Sites Requiring Remedial Action

67400.1. Selection Criteria.

Candidate sites shall be selected for hazardous waste site ranking
if:

(a) The site is presently not owned by the Federal Government,
and

(b) The release or threatened release of a hazardous substance
(as defined in Health and Safety Code Section 25316) at the site has
been confirmed by the Department by means of on-site sampling
conducted by the Department or other parties of the waste, soils,
sediments, ground water, surface water or air.

67400.2. Site Ranking Criteria.

Hazardous waste sites shall be ranked for remedial action according to the "Uncontrolled Hazardous Waste Site Ranking System, A User's Manual" published by the federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) (1982), except that the "NFPA 49-1975" as contained in either the 1977 or 1984 edition of the "Fire Protection Guide on Hazardous Materials" published by the National Fire Protection Association (Quincy, MA) may be used instead of the National Fire Protection Association's National Fire Codes, Vol. 13, No. 49 (1977).
