15-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE AND COMMENT PERIOD NOTICE OF PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF POST-HEARING CHANGES

TRANSPORTABLE TREATMENT UNIT STANDARDIZED PERMIT DEPARTMENT REFERENCE NUMBER: R-96-57

Pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.8(c), notice is hereby given that the Department of Toxic Substances Control has revised the text of the proposed regulations which would establish operating standards and requirements appropriate for Transportable Treatment Units (TTU) that are not eligible for operation under a lower permitting tier.

A public hearing was held March 30, 2000. Written and oral testimony was accepted at that hearing. In addition, written comments were accepted during the 45-day public comment period which ended March 30, 2000. Post-hearing changes were made to the proposed text.

A 15-day public notice was sent out August 21, 2000. Written comments were accepted until September 5, 2000. Post-hearing changes were made to the proposed text.
