FIELD WORK BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2019- JUNE 2019

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is sending this work notice to inform the community about upcoming activities at the Saving Cleaners Site located at 39480 Fremont Boulevard in Fremont, California 94538 (Site). DTSC is overseeing remediation of soil vapor and groundwater containing volatile organic compounds (VOCs) above Site cleanup goals. **From March through June 2019**, soil vapor monitoring wells, sub slab depressurization (SSD) system, soil vapor extraction (SVE) system and groundwater monitoring well will be installed at the Site. Following the completion of installation and sampling activities, **the SVE system is expected to operate for two months to one year based on the reduction in VOCs that is achieved.** The work will be conducted within the Site boundaries and not in the public right-of-way. **Activities at the Site be conducted Monday through Friday between 7 A.M. - 7 P.M.** **The work is expected to take approximately two months to a year to complete.**

You will see following:

- Workers wearing safety gear and operating drilling and other equipment; Noticeable noise and vibration during drilling activities;
- Workers will be drilling one groundwater monitoring well in the parking lot;
- Workers will be installing soil vapor monitoring wells, the SSD system, and SVE system;
- The SVE system will be operated and soil vapor and groundwater sampling will be performed for two months to one year.

This work will be conducted according to the Final Removal Action Workplan DTSC has approved.

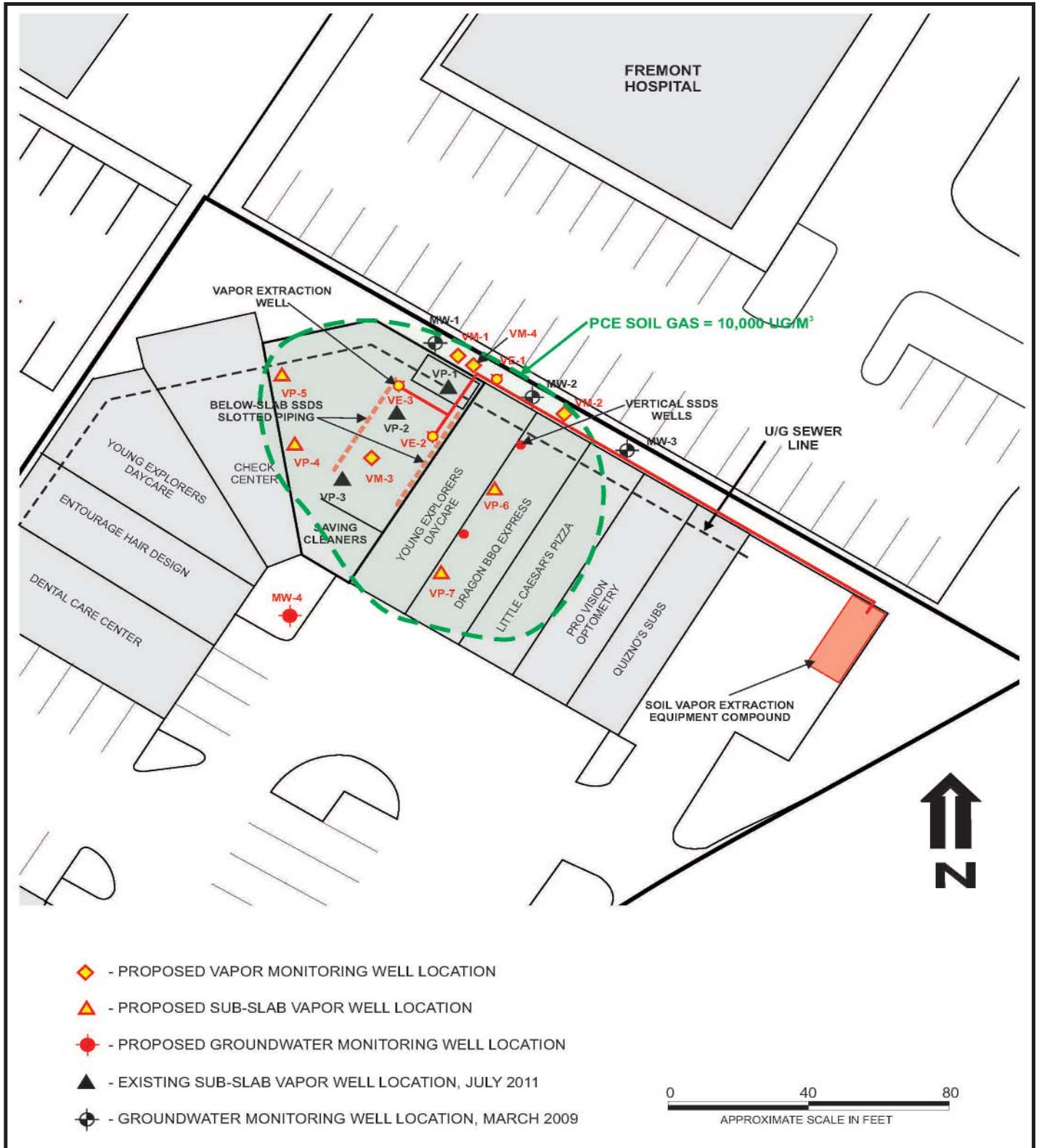


Figure 1 Saving Cleaners Site Conceptual Remediation System Implementation Layout
