EMERGENCY PERMIT Arena Pharmaceuticals 6138 Nancy Ridge Drive, San Diego, CA 92121 Effective: November 5, 2018 through January 4, 2019

On October 22, 2018, Arena Pharmaceuticals, a biotechnology facility, requested an Emergency Permit from the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for on-site treatment of expired chemicals at 6138 Nancy Ridge Drive, San Diego, CA 92121. The items to be treated are: 2,2 asozbisisobutyronitrile (five containers of 100 grams and one container of 5 pounds) and 1-methyl-3-nitro-nitrosoguanidine (10 grams). Clean Harbors Environmental Services has been contracted to conduct this treatment.

The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported off-site for proper management. DTSC has determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment, if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from **November 5, 2018 to January 4, 2019**. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and will file a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
