EMERGENCY PERMIT

DK DIXON

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) issued an Emergency Permit to DK Dixon (Facility) to transfer ignitable hazardous waste from a tanker truck to another tanker truck or container at its Facility. The Facility is located at 7300 Chevron Way in Dixon, California 95620. On December 7, 2018, a transporter, World Oil Environmental Services, arrived at the Facility to off-load approximately 350 gallons of waste antifreeze. The waste antifreeze was tested and found to be ignitable. The Facility does not have a permit to manage ignitable hazardous waste and the tanker truck does not meet the specifications that would allow it to transport ignitable hazardous waste.

DTSC has determined that the waste poses an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment, if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit was issued to allow the Facility to pump the waste from the truck to an approved truck or container and transport the waste off-site for proper treatment or disposal. The Emergency Permit was effective from **December 14 - 28, 2018**. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment. The Facility is required to submit a follow-up report to DTSC verifying that all hazardous waste was safely transferred.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
