EMERGENCY PERMIT

On January 30, 2019, Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory requested an Emergency Permit from the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 1 Cyclotron Road, Berkeley, California 94720. The containers of chemicals are two 100-gram containers and one 25-gram container of Potassium. DTSC determined that the chemicals posed an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment when not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit was issued.

Clean Harbors Environmental Services was contracted to conduct this treatment. The treatment involved the addition of liquid solution to stabilize the Potassium. Once the chemical is treated, it will be transported offsite for proper management. This Emergency Permit was effective from February 7, 2019 through April 7, 2019. The Emergency Permit included measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
