EMERGENCY PERMIT

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to California State University, Fullerton for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 800 North State College Boulevard, Fullerton, California. The items to be treated are four 1-Liter containers of Ethyl Ether. The containers of Ethyl Ether are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. DTSC determined that they pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit should be issued.

Clean Harbors Environmental Services has been contracted to conduct this treatment. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the Ethyl Ether. Once they are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. This Emergency Permit is effective from March 14, 2019 through May 12, 2019. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
