## HAZARDOUS WASTE EMERGENCY PERMIT

DK Dixon  
DIXON, CALIFORNIA 95620

DTSC issued an Emergency Permit to DK Dixon to transfer ignitable hazardous waste from a tanker truck to another tanker truck or container at its facility located at 7300 Chevron Way, Dixon, California 95620. On September 26, 2018, a transporter, World Oil Environmental Services, arrived at the DK Dixon facility to off-load approximately 260 gallons of waste antifreeze. The waste antifreeze was tested and found to be ignitable. DK Dixon does not have a permit to manage ignitable hazardous waste and the tanker truck did not meet the specifications that would allow it to transport ignitable hazardous waste.

DTSC determined that the waste posed an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment, if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit was issued to allow DK Dixon to pump the waste from the truck to an approved truck or container and transport the waste offsite for proper treatment or disposal. This Emergency Permit was effective from October 4, 2018 through October 31, 2018. The Emergency Permit included measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment. DK Dixon was required to submit a follow-up report to DTSC verifying that all hazardous waste was safely transferred.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA):** DTSC has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
