EMERGENCY PERMIT Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory Buildings 85, 67, 30, and 62 1 Cyclotron Road, Berkeley, California 94720

What is being proposed?

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory for onsite treatment of expired chemicals in Buildings 85, 67, 30, and 62 at 1 Cyclotron Road, Berkeley, CA 94720. These expired chemicals are potentially unstable and can be peroxide forming, shock-sensitive, and temperature-sensitive. Therefore, they must be stabilized before they are shipped for disposal.

The Clean Harbors Environmental Services Company has been contracted to conduct this treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the container(s) to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from April 26, 2019 through July 24, 2019. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

DTSC has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
