Hazardous Waste Emergency Permit Pharmavite

28310 Livingston Avenue
Valencia, CA 91355

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Pharmavite for onsite treatment of expired chemicals located at 28310 Livingston Avenue, Valencia, CA 91355. The items to be treated include seven containers of Diethyl Ether (three 1-liter containers and four 4-liter containers).

The Clean Harbors Environmental Services company has been contracted to conduct this treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from June 6, 2019 through August 5, 2019. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
