EMERGENCY PERMIT DOW CHEMICAL COMPANY PITTSBURG, CALIFORNIA 94509

On January 31, 2019, Dow Chemical Company requested an Emergency Permit from the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 901 Loveridge Road, Pittsburg, CA 94509. The items to be treated include one container of Vinyl Acetate (1 liter) and one container of Methyl Styrene (100 milliliter).

The Clean Harbors Environmental Services company has been contracted to conduct this treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from February 14, 2019 through April 15, 2019. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): D T S C has determined that the project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
