HAZARDOUS WASTE EMERGENCY PERMIT
SUPERIOR READY MIX
1508 MISSION ROAD

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Superior Ready Mix for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 1508 Mission Road, Escondido, California. The items to be treated are three 500 grams containers of 2,4 Dinitrophenylhydrazine. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. DTSC determined that they pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit should be issued.

Clean Harbors Environmental Services has been contracted to conduct this treatment. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once they are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. This Emergency Permit is effective from June 12, 2019 through August 10, 2019. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
